




Each bus stop on our fixed route service is indicated as small a blue dot on the map. Major transfer points are large white circles with a red dot in the center. Each route is numbered and color coded.

The corresponding subdivision that a route travels through is identified with a color coded box containing information about bus service frequency and hours of operation. Landmarks and identifying areas of interest throughout Park City have been added to the Transit map to aid in locating destinations.



A Dial-A-Ride icon is located on the map with a list of destinations in the Quinn's Junction service area.

Step 2: In the “From” search field, enter your departure location and in the “To” search field, enter your destination address.


Step 3: Click on the “By Transit” button. Scheduled departure time and routing information will be displayed. Choose the best trip option to suit your schedule.

THE ROUTE

Through a cooperative effort between Utah Transit Authority, Park City and Summit County, the PC-SLC Connect will service markets in Summit County and Salt Lake City during peak commute times. Summit County stops will include the Old Town Transit Center, Kimball Junction busstop and Jenny Holm. Salt Lake City stops will include Salt Lake Central Station and the University of Utah. To view route times and additional information, please log on to www.rideuta.com.

BUSES

Vehicles for the route are UTA express coaches. These coaches are built for longer routes and are equipped with blue seats and WiFi when available. **PAYING YOUR FARE** Fare payment methods include cash, contactless tap debit/credit cards and UTA electronic fare cards provided by participating employers or purchased online at www.rideuta.com. The cost to ride is \$5.50 for a one-way trip. Three-day or 30-day passes are also available. ECO and GO passes are not accepted.

TRANSFERS

The PC-SLC Connect is a special service. Transfers to or from PC-SLC Connect to the UTA system will not be allowed. Park City Transit is a free service. BUS STOPS

For the safety of passengers, drivers are instructed to pick-up and drop-off at designated bus stops. Bus stops are easy to find. Just look for the blue signs with white lettering. Routes and departure times will be posted at each stop. Locations of all bus stops and transfer points are indicated on the route map. Please plan to arrive at the bus stop a few minutes before the scheduled departure time. As the bus approaches, please check the destination display on the front of the bus to ensure you are boarding the correct bus.

WHILE ON THE BUS

We welcome you aboard. If all seats are full, please move away from the doors to allow others to board. **SAFETY:** Please remain seated while on the bus. Smoking, eating, drinking and animals (with the exception of service animals) are not allowed on the bus.

A Door-to-Door Nonfixed service is also provided for passengers that are unable to use the fixed-route service. 



Vehicles for the route are UTA express coaches. These coaches are built for longer routes and are equipped with bike racks and WIFI where available.

PAYING YOUR FARE

Fare payment methods include cash, contactless tap debit/credit cards and UTA electronic fare cards provided by participating employers or purchased online at www.rideuta.com. The cost to ride is \$5.50 for a one-way trip. Three-day or 30-day passes are also available. ECO and ED passes are not accepted.

TRANSFERS

The **PC-SLC Connect** is a special service. Transfers to or from **PC-SLC Connect** to the UTA system will not be allowed. Park City Transit is a free service. Therefore, a transfer is not necessary.




