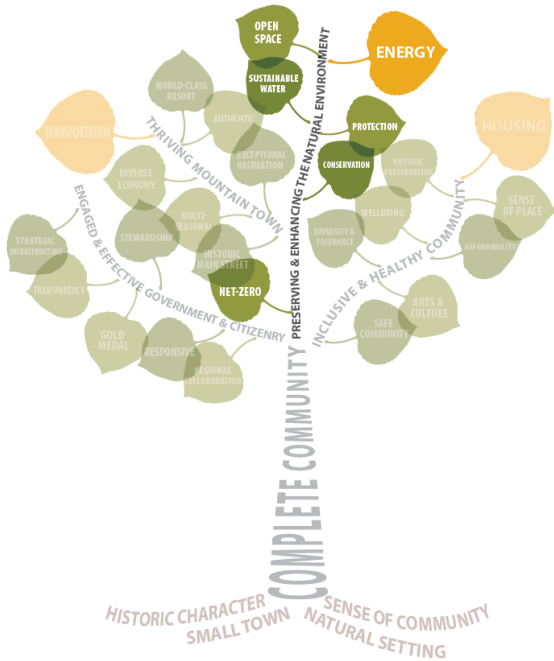

### Goals:

- Acquire open space properties while being financially prudent

- Involve stakeholders early in the decision-making process

### Accomplishments:

- Bonanza Flat purchase
- Created web-page specific to Bonanza Flat
- Identified areas and planted trees for open space carbon sequestration program
- COSAC recommendations
- Wildlife mitigation projects
- Off-leash Designation

### Next Steps:

- Bonanza Flat Community Preserve: Working with Utah Open Lands to complete the resource inventory, baseline documentation and adaptive management plan (conservation easement)
- Library Field Preservation Project: Deliver report to Council and implement direction
- Old Ranch Hills Preservation Project: RFP has been posted; staff will draft easement and return to Council
- Implement sign-age and monitoring of permitted and prohibited uses, including camping, hunting, trespass and motorized uses
- Adding kiosks to the trails with grant: Cove trailhead, Twins and Round Valley Way; use old ones to go in smaller trailheads
