- Address roadway infrastructure needs




## PROJECT ELEMENTS



## SHARING THE ROAD

#### **Hours of Operation**

7 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, some Saturdays

#### **Night Work**

Night work *not* anticipated

### **Holidays**

Work will take place on Pioneer Day, but will not occur on Labor Day

#### **Noise Mitigation**

Contractor will use white noise for all construction equipment and back-up alarms



## SHARING THE ROAD

#### **Park City Bus Stops**

City stops will be maintained

#### **School Bus Stops**

Stops will be relocated to Bonanza Drive

#### **Garbage Pick-up**

Will be maintained during construction

#### **Mail Delivery**

Will be maintained during construction

#### **On-Street Parking**

Will *not* be permitted during construction



## PROSPECTOR SQUARE

Improvements to Lots D and H (sidewalks, landscape, lighting, and pavement)

Miller paving crews will complete their work in the roadway before Prospector Avenue work begins. Their focus will be on parking lot work through the remainder of the project.
