### REDUCED SPRING TRANSIT SERVICE

Effective **TUESDAY, MARCH 24, 2020**, Park City Transit is reducing service frequency and hours of operation on some routes. Working together, we can help slow COVID-19.

- 1 Red— Reduced to 40-minute frequency
- **2 Green** Reduced to 40-minute frequency
- **6 Lime** Service ends at 11:15 PM. 30-minute frequency all hours.
- **7 Pink** Service ends at 11:15 PM. 30-minute frequency all hours.
- **8 Brown** Service ends at 11:30 PM. 30-minute frequency all hours.
- **9 Purple**—Effective immediately, service is suspended until further notice.
- **10 White** Service ends at 11:10 PM. Reduced to 15-minute frequency all day.
- 11 Black— No changes
- AM City Wide— Departs Fresh Market at 5:25, 5:45, 6:25 AM.
- PM City Wide— One bus departs 11:14 PM from Old Town Transit Center (OTTC).

### **SOCIAL DISTANCING**

We are asking our riders to continue practicing social distancing and good hygiene habits. Together, we can help keep each other healthy.

- **1**. Stay home if you're ill. Even if you're well, avoid all unnecessary trips.
- **2.** If you do need to ride Park City Transit, please board through the rear doors to protect our drivers. An exception is made for riders who need the kneeling ramp at the front door.
