



HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

- Locate your trip destination on the map. The blue area to the lower left shows the PC-SLC Connect service to Salt Lake City. The rest of the map shows our routes and destinations in Park City and Summit County.
- Not every destination is listed here, but you should be able to locate one nearby.
- Routes servicing select destinations are indicated by color.
- Major transfer points are Park City Mountain and the Old Town Transit Center.
- Service frequency is indicated on the map.
- Scheduled departure times and enhanced real-time bus tracking signs are posted at each bus stop as well as inside the Old Town Transit Center on the electronic board.
- Timetables are also available in the Old Town Transit Center and transit buses.

AVL Bus Tracker is available over the internet and provides riders with real-time bus tracking schedules and current locations.

PARK CITY MOBILITY
All Park City/Summit County transit buses are ADA accessible and our drivers are trained to assist those with disabilities.

A Door-to-Door Paratransit service is also provided for passengers that are unable to use the fixed-route service. SAFE HAVEN PROGRAM
If you feel that you are in imminent danger, just board a Park City Transit bus. Drivers are in direct contact with the police department.

WHILE ON THE BUS
We welcome you aboard our free bus system. Traffic and parking around town can be challenging, so ride the bus and relax. Our drivers can be a good source of information, feel free to ask questions. Seats near the front of the bus should be offered to the elderly and riders with disabilities. For the safety and comfort of all passengers, please refrain from playing music without earphones. Smoking, eating, drinking and animals (with the exception of service animals) are prohibited.

EARLY MORNING AND LATE NIGHT IN-TOWN BUS SERVICE
Special routes and schedules (city wide) are available for service between 5:40 am and 8:00 am. Late night bus service operates from midnight to 2:10 am. Late night service is shown in the table on the reverse side of this map. For more information, please call 435-615-5301. You may also dial our pre-recorded routing information line 435-615-5350 or log on to www.parkcitytransit.org.

HWY 224 EXPRESS SERVICE
An Express Bus travels directly between Park City's Old Town Transit Center (OTTC) and Kimball Junction (in 15 minutes), departing the OTTC on the hour. The first Express bus departs at Kimball Junction at 7:00 am; the last express bus departs at Midnight.

The Express bus also departs Kimball Junction at Newpark for Park City's Historic Main Street (~45 minutes after the hour, from 7:45 am until 12:45 am.

CANYONS EVENING EXPRESS
The 6 Lime Evening Express service connects the Canyons Village area with Park City base Mountain area and Main Street (Old Town Transit Center) providing 20 minute frequency. For Current information, see the reverse side and our Transit Timetable or Log on to our website, www.parkcitytransit.org.

Through a cooperative effort between Utah Transit Authority, Park City and Summit County, the PC-SLC Connect will service markets in Summit County and Salt Lake City during peak commute times. Summit County stops will include two ski resorts, the Old Town Transit Center, Kimball Junction businesses and Jeremy Ranch Park & Ride. Salt Lake City stops will include the Salt Lake Central Station and the University of Utah.
