Halloween Driving Safety Tips



Halloween driving "tricks" to keep everyone safe:

- Put the phone down!
- Stay well below the posted speed limit.
- Pay attention to what's happening on sidewalks and roadways. Watch for children darting across streets, especially between parked cars.
- Do not assume children can see you or are paying attention.
- Do not pass other vehicles that have stopped in the roadway. They could be dropping off children.

Parents can help motorists, too:

- Make sure drivers can see the children. Give them flashlights and glow sticks. Dress kids in bright, reflective clothing or use reflective tape on their costumes.
- Use makeup, rather than masks, so children have a clear, unobstructed view of their surroundings.
- Be sure children know how to cross a street -- look left, right and left again before crossing.
- Accompany your children as they trick or treat.
- Take advantage of Park City's "Halloween on Main" from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. PCPD officers will be assisting with traffic control and overall event safety.

Additionally, the police department will have extra traffic officers assigned to DUI detection and enforcement on Halloween night.
