

Volunteer Job Description

Park City Ice Arena

Position: Ice Removal and Installation Project Helper

Job Description:

Workers volunteering for this position will be involved in all aspects of removing the ice sheet, including actual removal of ice and related tasks, cleaning the rink floor, equipment and surrounding areas, cleaning dashers and rink glass, repairing and adjusting dasher components, painting the floor with a solvent-based paint and building the new ice sheet.

Job Duties:

Job duties may include, but are not limited to:

- Remove ice by using shovels, squeegees and ice choppers to break-up ice, remove from the floor and squeegee the floor dry.
- Clean the rink floor with mops.
- Prepare the concrete floor for painting.
- Assist in measuring and marking the rink floor for proper placement of all sport marking and logos.
- Paint the floor with rollers and paint brushes.
- Clean puck marks off the dashers and glass.
- Clean rubber flooring around rink, equipment and resurfacer room to remove any ice paint residue.
- Prepare painted floor for making ice.
- Assist in building ice surface by holding and moving hose as needed.
- Replace damaged lexan dasher ad covers.

Work Environment:

The following conditions may be experienced during some phases of the project:

- Cold, wet conditions.
- Long periods of standing, crouching, kneeling.
- Possible work on wet ice.
- Possible noisy situations when machinery in use.
- Slippery, uneven, inconsistent standing surfaces.
- Fumes from power equipment and paint.

Requirements:

In order to complete the tasks related to this position, the volunteer must be able to:

- Lift over 25 lbs.
- Perform strenuous manual labor for extended periods.
- Paint within lines as instructed.
- Follow directions.
- Provide own clean non-marking sole footwear.
- Provide clothing and footwear that may become wet, damaged or stained during the project.
- Work in a cold, wet environment for extended periods during some phases of the project.
