

Section 1. It is hereby declared that the purpose of this Ordinance is to safeguard the safety of the inhabitants and visitors of the City, and that the skiing areas within the City be controlled and regulated to accomplish this goal.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, for the purpose of skiing or other reason, to willfully go upon any area designated by the sheriff, Forest Service, National Park Service or Ski Patrol as unsafe.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect on or after twenty (20) days after its posting, or after thirty (30) days after its passage whichever of said days is most remote from the passage of this ordinance.
