Summit County, Utah (August 20, 2021) — Leadership Park City's Class 27 is proud to announce their class project. As part of the year-long program, the class envisions, plans, and implements a class service project to benefit greater Park City and the Summit County community. In past years, projects have supported public art, green building, water conservation, voter awareness, and many other issues. Each year, projects are selected by the class through a voting process.

The project this year is called "Every Voice Belongs: A Model for Inclusive Participation," and it will help identify community and inform voting maps through in-person and online gatherings. The project's goals include deepening connectedness and belonging throughout the Park City community, raising awareness about the diversity of the community, and collecting information that represents various opinions. Participants will share their viewpoints and define their community boundaries so they can be fairly considered when new voting district lines are determined this year, a process that happens once a decade.

The resulting data collected through this project will be shared community-wide, and community maps drawn will be shared with the Utah Independent Redistricting Commission. The project also includes the creation of an Equity & Inclusion Starter Guide that will be shared with all participants and provide tools that they can use in the future to ensure that every voice counts in Summit County.
