- 1. Special Exception Permit (1977).
- 2. Amended 12 times, most recently in 2016.
- 3. Authorizes Densities for Lower Deer Valley, American Flag, and Silver Lake neighborhoods, including Commercial and Support space in Snow Park.
- 4. The Deer Valley MPD authorizes 209.75 Unit Equivalents for Snow Park Village, and 21,890 square feet of remaining Commercial and Support Uses.
- 5. One Unit Equivalent = 2,000 square feet of Residential Density (or one Single-Family Dwelling).

UTAH CODE -

Utah State Code <u>§ 10-9a-609.5</u>, Vacation of public ROW is a discretionary legislative act and requires findings of:

a) good cause exists for the vacation; and

b) neither the public interest nor any person will be materially injured by the vacation.



PARK CITY LMC

Park City LMC § 15-7-7, incorporates the Utah Code, and § 15-15-1, defines "Good Cause" as follows:

Providing positive benefits and mitigating negative impacts, determined on a case by case basis to include such things as: providing public amenities and benefits, resolving existing issues and non-conformities, addressing issues related to density, promoting excellent and sustainable design, utilizing best planning and design practices, preserving the character of the neighborhood and of Park City and furthering the health, safety, and welfare of the Park City community.



Resolution 8-98 -

Park City <u>Resolution 8-98</u>:

"Adopting a Policy Statement Regarding the Vacation of Public Right-of-Ways within Park City, Utah"

This Resolution is general guidance and advisory.

The Resolution states the policy guidelines "shall only be advisory for the Planning Commission and City Council to utilize when exercising their legislative discretion in evaluating the merits of a vacation petition."

The City's Resolution criteria does not change the State standards.
