PARK CITY MUNICIPAL SEEKS INPUT ON HOUSING NEEDS AND ISSUES

Survey available on-line until June 30.

June 20, 2012, Park City Utah

Park City Municipal is asking Parkites to take a few minutes to complete a survey on your housing needs and issues. The survey will help the City better understand the housing concerns of residents and the local workforce.

Every five years the City prepares a housing needs assessment that looks at housing affordability, particularly for lower income households, the level of current housing need and the projected housing demand, and identifies strategies to address these needs. This plan is also submitted to the State Division of Housing and Community Development in compliance with state law.

The survey is a part of a comprehensive data collection and analysis process that also includes 2010 Census data, a housing market assessment completed by the University of Utah Bureau of Business and Economic Research, interviews with Human Resources departments, and local focus groups.
