

Each bus stop on our fixed route service is indicated as small a blue dot on the map. Major transfer points are large white circles with a red dot in the center.



Each route is numbered and color coded. The corresponding subdivision that a route travels through is identified with a color coded box containing information about bus service frequency and hours of operation. Landmarks and identifying areas of interest throughout Park City have been added to the Transit map to aid in locating destinations.



**THE ROUTE**

Through a cooperative effort between Utah Transit Authority, Park City and Summit County, the PC-SLC Connect will service markets in Summit County and Salt Lake City during peak commute times.

Summit County stops will include the Old Town Transit Center, Kimball Junction busstop and Jeremy Ranch, Salt Lake City stops will include Salt Lake Central Station and the University of Utah. **BUSES**

Vehicles for the route are UTA express coaches. These coaches are built for longer routes and are equipped with large racks and WiFi when available.

**PAYING YOUR FARE**

Fare payment methods include cash, contactless tap, debit/credit cards and UTA electronic fare cards provided by participating employers or purchased online at [www.rideuta.com](http://www.rideuta.com). The cost to ride is \$2.50 for a one-way trip. Three-day or 30-day passes are also available. \$20 and \$30 passes are not accepted.

**TRANSFERS**

The PC-SLC Connect is a special service. Transfers to or from PC-SLC Connect to the UTA system will not be allowed. Park City Transit is a bus service. Therefore, a transfer is not necessary.

**BUS STOPS**

For the safety of passengers, drivers are instructed to pick-up and drop-off at designated bus stops. Bus stops are easy to find. Just look for the blue signs with white lettering. Routes and departure times will be posted at each stop. Locations of all bus stops and transfer points are indicated on the route maps. Please plan to arrive at the bus stop a few minutes before the scheduled departure time. As the bus approaches, please check the destination display on the front of the bus to ensure you are boarding the correct bus.

**WHILE ON THE BUS**

We welcome you aboard. If all seats are full, please move away from the doors to allow others to board. Seats near the front of the bus should be offered to the elderly and riders with disabilities. For the safety and comfort of all passengers, please refrain from playing music without headphones while on the bus. Smoking, eating, drinking and animals (with the exception of service animals) are not allowed on the bus.

**MAIN STREET TROLLEY SERVICE**

The trolley operates along Main Street daily from 10:00 am until 10:00 pm. It will stop just west of downtown along Main Street. Stand at any trolley stop or just wave to the driver indicating you would like to ride. The trolley also serves as a connection to the Old Town Transit Center where transfers can be made to all other routes in the system.



**PARK CITY MOBILITY**

All Park City/Summit County transit buses are ADA accessible and our drivers are trained to assist those with disabilities. A Door-to-Door Paratransit service is also provided for passengers that are unable to use the fixed-route service. For further information and an ADA Eligibility Application, contact our Paratransit Certification Office, Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, 435-615-0303, TTY 435-615-7041 (please leave a message).

**SAFE HAVEN PROGRAM**

If you feel that you are in imminent danger, just board a Park City Transit bus. Drivers are in direct contact with the police department.







A map of Park City and Salt Lake City area displays the PC-SLC route.






