

**REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS
GRANULAR ACTIVATED CARBON FILTER MEDIA REPLACEMENT
ADDENDUM #1**

Proposals from qualified firms to remove and dispose of existing granular activated carbon (GAC) filter media, provide new GAC media, install GAC media in an existing pressure vessel, and provide start-up support services will be received by the Park City Municipal Corporation (PCMC) Department of Public Utilities, located at 1053 Iron Horse Drive, P.O. Box 1480, Park City 84060, **until 4:00 p.m., Thursday July 2, 2015 (local time)**. No proposals will be accepted after the specified time and date. Request for Proposals ("RFP") packets and any issued addenda are available electronically, Adobe Software will be needed to view the documents. A hard copy will be available for viewing at the Park City Municipal Public Utilities Department office.

The purpose of this RFP is to select one contractor to perform turn-key GAC media replacement required to replace filter media at the existing Quinns Junction Water Treatment Facility. The choice of which CONTRACTOR is chosen for the project will be at the discretion of the Department of Public Utilities based on the criteria set forth in this RFP. Media replacement is of the essence of time and is anticipated to be completed at the earliest opportunity.

No verbal response shall be binding.
