PARK CITY MUNCIPAL LAUNCHES REDESIGNED WEBSITE

October 29, 2015 (Park City, UT) – Park City Municipal launches its redesigned website, <u>www.parkcity.org</u>, today. The revamped site features a fresh look, dynamic content, easier navigation, and enhanced search functions, making it easier for residents and visitors to access municipal information.

"Our website is an important tool in engaging with our community and providing access to government resources, information and programs," said City Manager Diane Foster. "The improved mobile access also furthers our commitment to high quality customer service and government transparency," Foster added.

In addition to its visual appeal, the redesigned website has several new features and enhancements that users will find helpful. The upgraded site is also compatible with all common web browsers. Shannon Dale, the City's IT Coordinator, and project manager for the website redesign, explained that *"enhanced search features allow users to find items quickly and with fewer clicks. The website is also more user-friendly for staff. Information can be uploaded to the site more quickly, facilitating information access and public accountability."*
