



PARKING REGULATIONS & HINTS

As part of the approved Sundance Traffic Mitigation Plan, the following changes have been implemented this year to help manage overall transportation, traffic, and parking issues, as well as facilitate deliveries to the Downtown area:

MAIN STREET – IMPACTS & CLOSURES

No parking will be allowed on Main Street from 1/19 – 1/30.

This area will become a drop-and-load zone for deliveries, taxis, and private vehicles.

This is strictly enforced with fines of \$150.00 and towing.

Parking Restrictions Timeline:

Thursday, 1/21/16 (3:00AM)	<p>Main Street CLOSED to Parking (Both East and West Sides).</p> <p>Drop-and-Load in effect.</p> <p>Venue Load-in/Load-outs allowed with approved permit.</p>

Drop-and-Load Zone Regulations:

- Both sides of Main Street (9th Street – top of Main)
- Driver must remain in vehicle
- Strictly enforced with \$150 fine and towing

Extended Parking /Special Use Permits

Permits for extended parking periods in the Main Street Core Area may be obtained through the **Special**

Use of Public Parking Application process. Permits are required for:

- Venue Load-in/Load-out requests
- Satellite Trucks
- Lifts / Booms
- Crowd Control/Mitigation
- PODS / Storage/Etc.

PUBLIC PARKING

Public parking in the Old Town core area will be by permit or pay only January 22 – 31, 2015. Main Street patrons and Main Street employees are encouraged to ride the bus to avoid traffic and parking problems in Old Town. The last Citywide bus departs the Main Street Transit Center at 2:30am.

Paid Parking Options:

Paid parking is available in the China Bridge Parking Structure, Flagpole and Brew Pub Lots.

China Bridge Parking Structure and Flagpole Lot:

(Paid Parking from January 21 – 30)

\$25.00 per entry* (Starting Thursday, 1/21/16)

\$10.00 per entry* (Starting Tuesday, 1/26/16) * There are no in-and-out privileges.

Brew Pub Lot – Metered Parking

The Brew Pub Lot metered parking will increase from January 22-30.

Cost is \$16 for 3 hours

Black Diamond Permits

Guaranteed Sundance Parking, China Bridge Level S2, January 21-30) are available for \$450.

Free Parking Options:

The following offer free parking during the Sundance Film Festival:

(Please note: Free parking options in the Old Town core area are extremely limited and fill quickly.)

Sandridge Lots (Located off of Marsac Avenue)

City Park

Near the Eccles & MARC theatres at 2300 Monitor Drive (Monday-Friday, 3:00 p.m.—midnight, all day parking Saturday, NO parking Sunday)

Deer Valley Lots 5 & 6 (AFTER 5:00pm Only. Last bus leaves transit center to lot approx. 2:30am)

Treasure Mountain Middle School (Weekends Only. Last bus leaves transit center to lot approx. 2:30am)

PERMIT HOLDERS

Main Street Employee & Residential Permits:

During the festival, those who possess **Main Street Employee (Green Dot)** or **Main Street Business (Blue Square)** or **Zone C Residential** permits may park for free on the roof of Old China Bridge (Level S4), in the North Marsac Lot, and the usual spots in the Gateway Center upper level lot accessed off of Heber Avenue. A permit guaranteeing a spot on in the China Bridge garage is available for \$450 and is valid

from January 22-30. This permit is available from Parking Services where you originally purchased your permit, or by calling 435-615-5301.

ADA PARKING

All current parking for disabled persons will remain available. Supplemental ADA spaces are available behind the Museum in Swede Alley below 5th Street. HINTS & PARKING TIPS

The following are suggestions to help with your commuting needs:

1. Carpool and share the expense of parking in the Old Town area.
2. Ride the FREE buses.
3. If possible, work out shifts that can take advantage of the after 5:00 PM free parking at Deer Valley Resort.
4. Think Flexible Scheduling: If you work in the morning, arrive early and try parking at City Park, Skateboard Park, or the east side of Park Avenue below the 900 Block and ride the bus.
