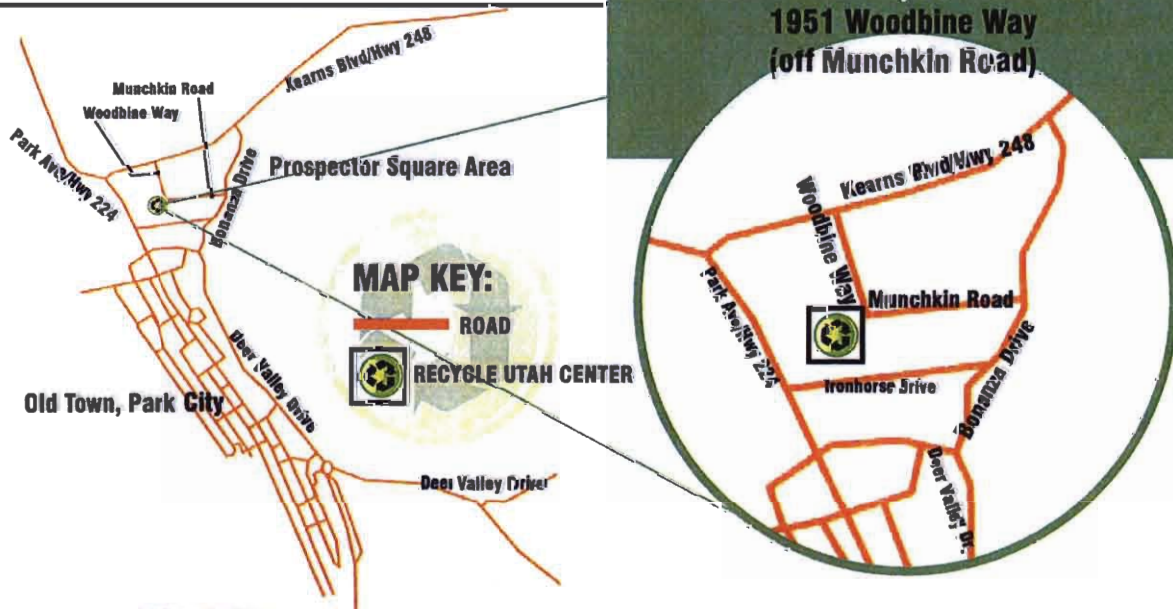

Below is a list of those **items that can be recycled** right here in Park City. All these items can be taken to the local recycling center located at 1959 Woodbine Way, Park City, Utah.



What can I recycle in Park City?

Packaging Materials:

- moving boxes
- bubble wrap
- styrofoam
- peanuts
- packing paper

ALL plastics

- self-sort at Recycle Utah Center

Cardboard

Paperboard

Plastic Bags

Paper:

- white paper
- colored paper
- "anything that comes in the mail"
- newspapers
- magazines

Clear/Green Glass

Brown Glass

Blue Glass

Electronics:

- batteries
- cell phones
- TVs
- stereos
- print cartridges
- microwaves
- computers
