Dear Ms. Whitesides:

I am responding to your concern about the threat to Park City, Utah's drinking water from the Creole Mine in the Spiro Drinking Water Source Protection Zone from your e-mail of 7/12/2016. Your e-mail was sent to the Source Water Protection Program for response.

Park City has an active Drinking Water Source Protection Program that addresses potential threats to your sources of drinking water. Mr. Kyle MacArthur, Water Distribution Manager for the Public Utilities Program, is responsible for implementing this plan. He should be able to answer your questions about how the drinking water source is protected. He may be reached at 435-615-5337 or by e-mail at kmacarthur@parkcity.org. I have copied him on this e-mail.

I have also spoken to both US EPA Region 8 and State clean-up programs for contaminated sites. This site is not currently involved under any of these programs, but could be in the future. The Utah Department of Environmental Quality's Voluntary Cleanup Program may be an avenue for a private owner to pursue cleanup of a contaminated site. Information may be found at
