

Ordinance No. 2017-34

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MUNICIPALITY TRANSIENT ROOM TAX WITHIN THE CITY OF PARK CITY, UTAH, AT ONE PERCENT (1%).

WHEREAS, the City Council has the power to establish a municipality transient room tax on amounts paid or charged for tourist home, hotel, motel, or trailer court accommodations and services that are regularly rented for less than 30 consecutive days pursuant to UCA Section 59-12-352.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARK CITY, UTAH THAT:


SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF A 1% MUNICIPALITY TRANSIENT ROOM TAX: In addition to any other tax authorized by the laws of the State of Utah and/or of this municipality, there hereby is established, approved, and levied a tax of one percent (1.0%) pursuant to UCA Section 59-12-352 on amounts paid or charged for tourist home, hotel, motel, or trailer court accommodations and services that are regularly rented for less than 30 consecutive days as described in UCA Subsection 59-12-103(1)(i).

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective on January 1, 2018.


