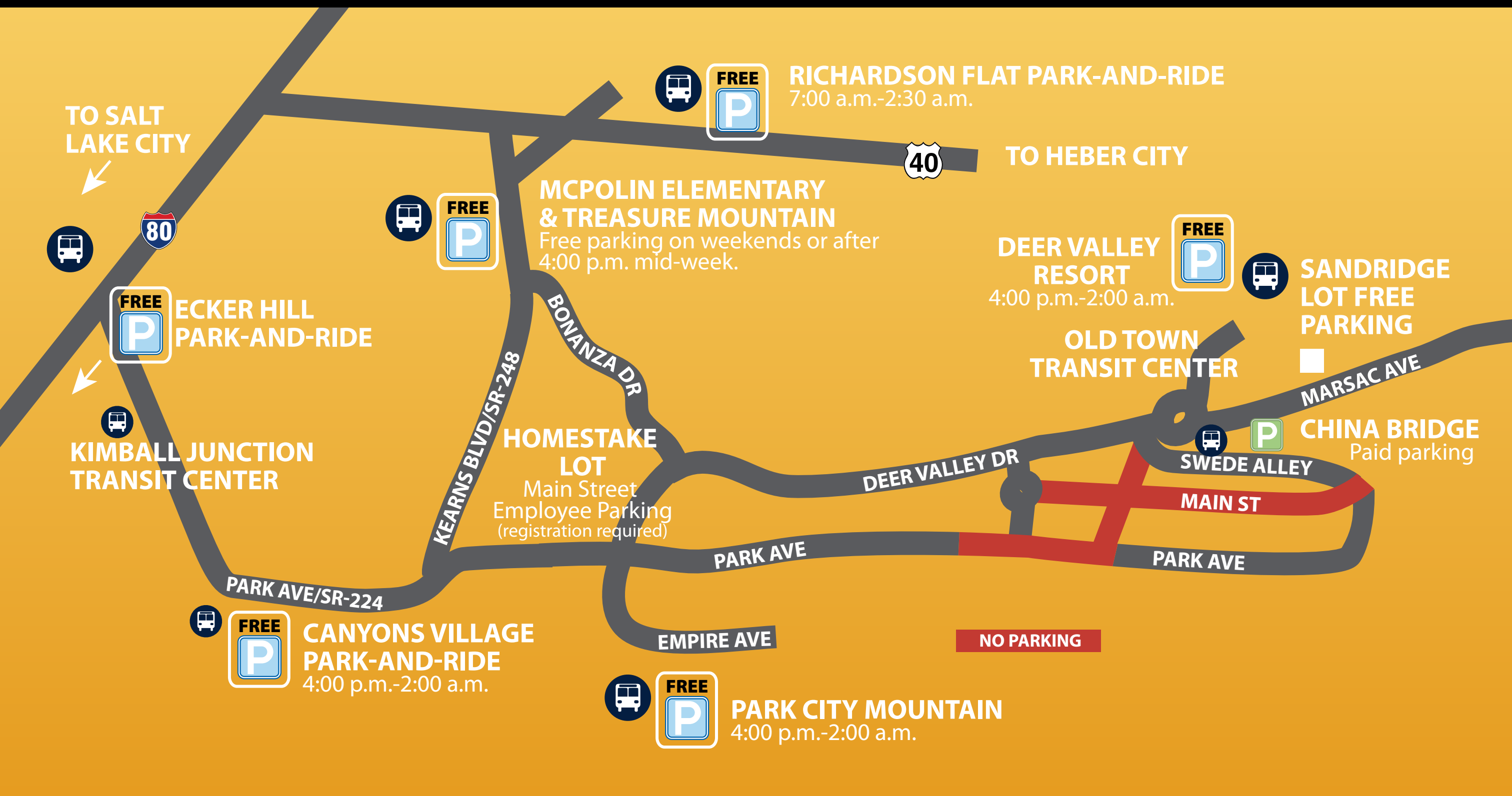

TAKE THE BUS

Use Park City Transit, carpool, or walk. The easiest, most efficient, and inexpensive way to get around town during the Festival is Park City's free transit system.



FREE PARKING

- Richardson Flat Parking Lot: 7:00 a.m.-2:30 a.m. January 24-February 2 with free transit to/from High School
- Homestake Lot: available to Main Street employees only, with proper registration from Parking Services. Free transit available to and from lot 8:00 a.m.-3:00 a.m. with on-call guaranteed ride home after 3:00 a.m.
- Ecker Hill Park-and-Ride: free parking at 2465 Kilby Road with free transit
- Deer Valley Resort/Park City Mountain lots: free after ski day January 24-February 2, 4:00 p.m.-2:00 a.m. only
- Sandridge Lots: free parking access via Marsac Avenue. Expected to fill quickly each morning
- McPolin Elementary/Treasure Jr. High: free parking on weekends or after 4:00 p.m. mid-week

PAID PARKING

- China Bridge Parking Structure (access via Marsac): January 24 - 28, \$40/day (cash preferred) January 29-February 2, \$5/hour (max \$40) 11:00 a.m.-2:00 a.m.
- Flagpole Parking Lot: January 24-February 2, \$40/day (cash preferred)
- Main Street Parking Permit Holders: blue square permit holders may park in North Marsac Lot and in Gateway Center (upper level). A guaranteed spot in China Bridge is available for \$550, valid January 24-February 2. Call 435.615.5301 to purchase
- Various private parking throughout Old Town. Private lots have varying payment structures and regulations with costs ranging between \$20-\$100/day



PARKING CLOSURES

- January 18-February 4: Bob Wells Plaza Parking Lot
- January 22-February 2: Brew Pub Parking Lot (for City operations)
- January 22: West Side of Main Street
- January 23-February 2: Park Avenue (from Heber Avenue to 11th Street)
- January 24-February 2: All of Main Street
- January 24-February 2: All of Heber Avenue
