



TAKE THE BUS

Use Park City Transit, carpool, or walk. The easiest, most efficient, and inexpensive way to get around town is Park City's free transit system. Resort parking lots expected to fill quickly each morning and for events. Please use alternative modes of transportation.



FREE PARKING

- Richardson Flat Carpool Lot. Lot for carpooling only. Transit services will not be available
- Homestake Lot: available to Main Street employees only, with proper registration from Parking Services. Register at homestakeparking@gmail.com. Free transit available to and from lot 8:00 a.m.-3:00 a.m. with on-call guaranteed ride home after 3:00 a.m.
- Ecker Hill Park-and-Ride: free parking at 2465 Kilby Road with free transit
- Deer Valley Resort/Park City Mountain lots: free after ski day February 1-10, 4:00 p.m.-2:00 a.m. only. Resort parking lots are expected to fill early
- Sandridge Lots: free parking access via Marsac Avenue. Expected to fill quickly
- McPolin Elementary/Treasure Jr. High: free parking on weekends or after 4:00 p.m. mid-week

PAID/PERMIT PARKING

- China Bridge Parking Structure (access via Marsac): February 1-2, \$5/hour (max \$40) 11:00 a.m.-2:00 a.m. February 3-10, normal peak parking rates - free until 5:00 p.m., \$3/hr after 5:00 p.m., first hour free
- Flagpole Parking Lot: January 24-February 2, \$40/day (cash preferred)
- Main Street Parking Permit Holders: blue square permit holders may park in North Marsac Lot and in Gateway Center (upper level). Call 435.615.5301 to purchase
- Carpool Permit holders should park in Sandridge Lots. If Sandridge Lots are full, Carpool Permit holders may park in North Marsac or China Bridge
- Various private parking throughout Old Town. Private lots have varying payment structures and regulations
