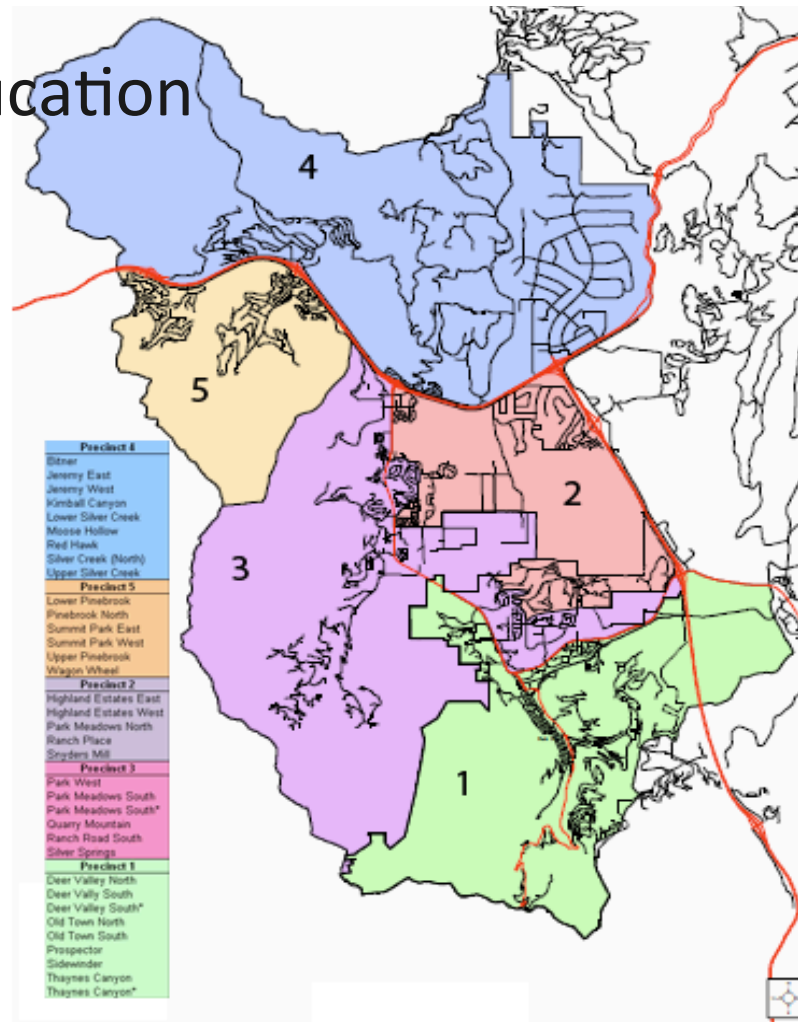

POPULATION PROJECTION WITHIN PCSD

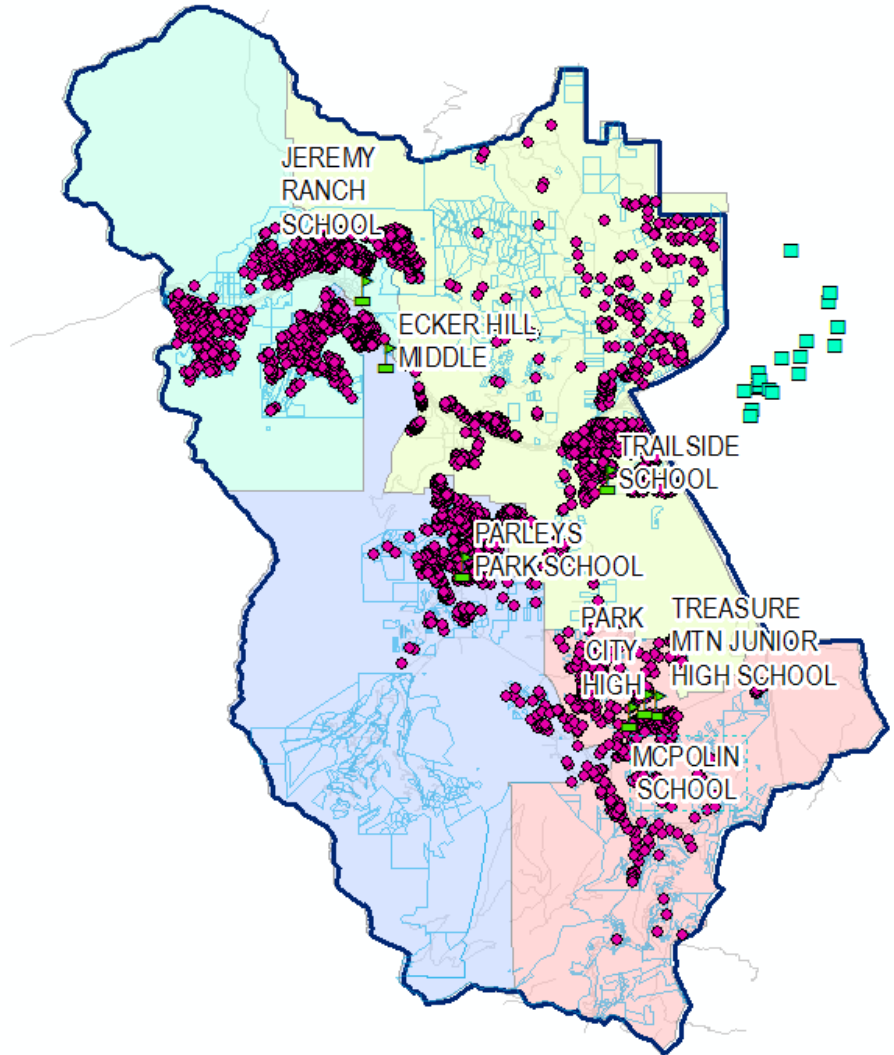

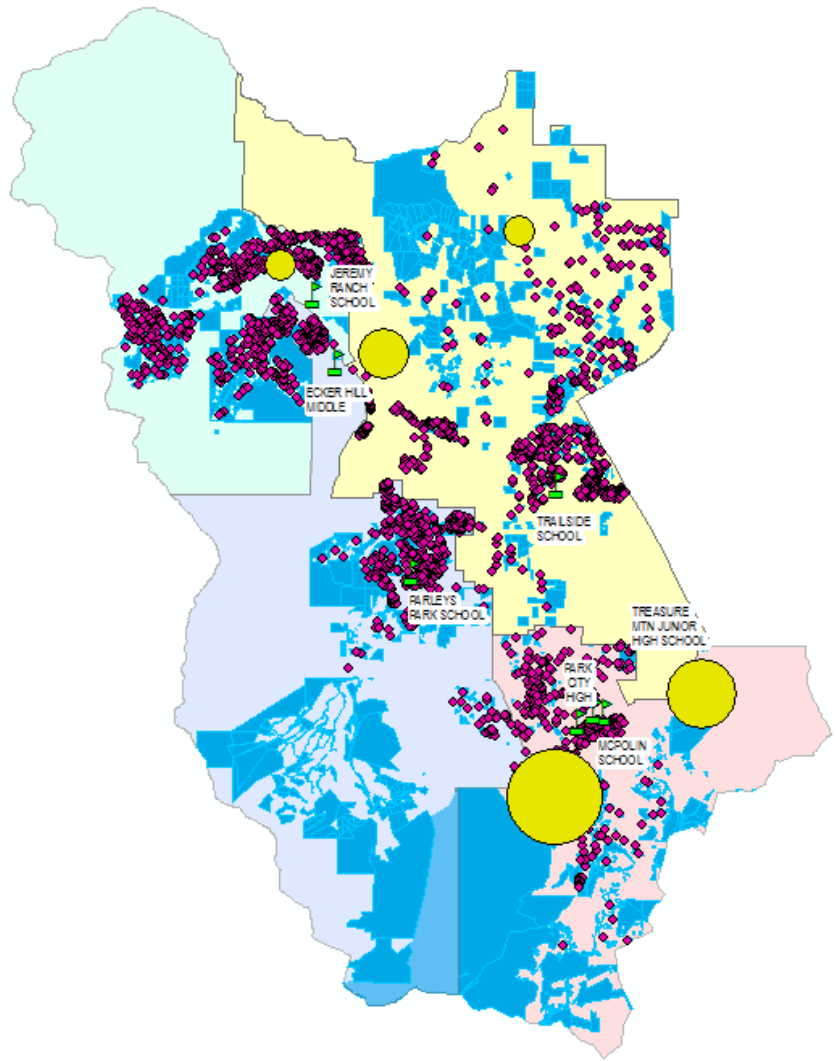

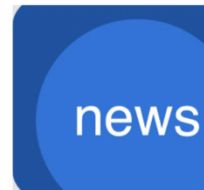
