


SPRING PARKING RATE AND TRANSIT SCHEDULE CHANGES

Beginning Monday, April 8, spring parking rates and transit schedules will be in effect. Here's what you need to know to get around town:



SPRING TRANSIT SCHEDULE

Park City Transit will be operating on a spring schedule April 8—June 7. Please visit parkcitytransit.org for up-to-date transit schedules, bus trackers, and to access the MyStop mobile app.



FREE PARKING

- Free parking is available 24 hours/day at the North Marsac, and Upper and Lower Sandridge lots
- Free parking is available outside the hours of 5:00 p.m.—12:00 a.m. at the following locations:
 - -Bob Wells Plaza
 - -Flagpole Lot
 - -Swede Alley




PAID PARKING

- Rates will be reduced to \$1/hour for all paid parking locations along Main Street, in Old Town, and in the China Bridge parking structure.
- China Bridge will remain free until 5:00 p.m., with the first hour free and \$1/hour thereafter (maximum charge \$6/day).

CARPOOL PERMIT PROGRAM

The employee carpool permit program allows for FREE parking in China Bridge for registered carpools of two or more people. Applicants must register in person at Park City Public Works (1053 Ironhorse Drive).



BLUE SQUARE PERMITS

Blue Square permits, which provide unlimited access to parking in the China Bridge and Gateway parking locations, are available for a prorated amount of \$200. These permits are \$400 for a full year.



GUARANTEED RIDE HOME PROGRAM (GRH)

Park City and Summit County offer a "Guaranteed Ride Home" program for commuters who use Park City Transit. Registered Participants who need transportation in case of an emergency can be reimbursed for their trip costs.
