TAKE FREE TRANSIT

Take free transit, or carpool to avoid and help reduce traffic. Free transit will be provided from the School District and Resort lots to the Main Street/Old Town Area. The City's <u>Electric Xpress</u> & <u>Kamas</u> Service are also running. On July 4, there will be a designated bus lane on Deer Valley Drive to expedite transit. Last bus leaves Park City Resort Base and Old Town Transit Center at 12:00 a.m.



BIKE AND WALK

Bike valet will be available at 9th Street during the parade. Utilize Park City's trail system, including the Rail Trail and Poison Creek, to walk to activities.



FREE AND PAID PARKING

Parking is free at the Ecker Hill Park-and-Ride, Park City School District lots on Kearns Blvd., Canyons Village, Park City Base and Deer Valley Resort with free transit to Main Street. Limited parking is available in China Bridge parking structure, accessed via Marsac Avenue, for \$20 (cash preferred) There are private parking garages in Old Town with varying parking rates.




PARADE ROUTE AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS

The Fourth of July parade begins at 11:00 a.m. at the top of Main Street and ends on Park Avenue North of City Park. Parking will be removed from the parade route beginning at 6:00 a.m. on Thursday, July 4. Plan ahead to avoid delays.



ROAD CLOSURES

Swede Alley, Main Street, Heber Avenue, and Park Avenue will be closed to all traffic from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 4.
