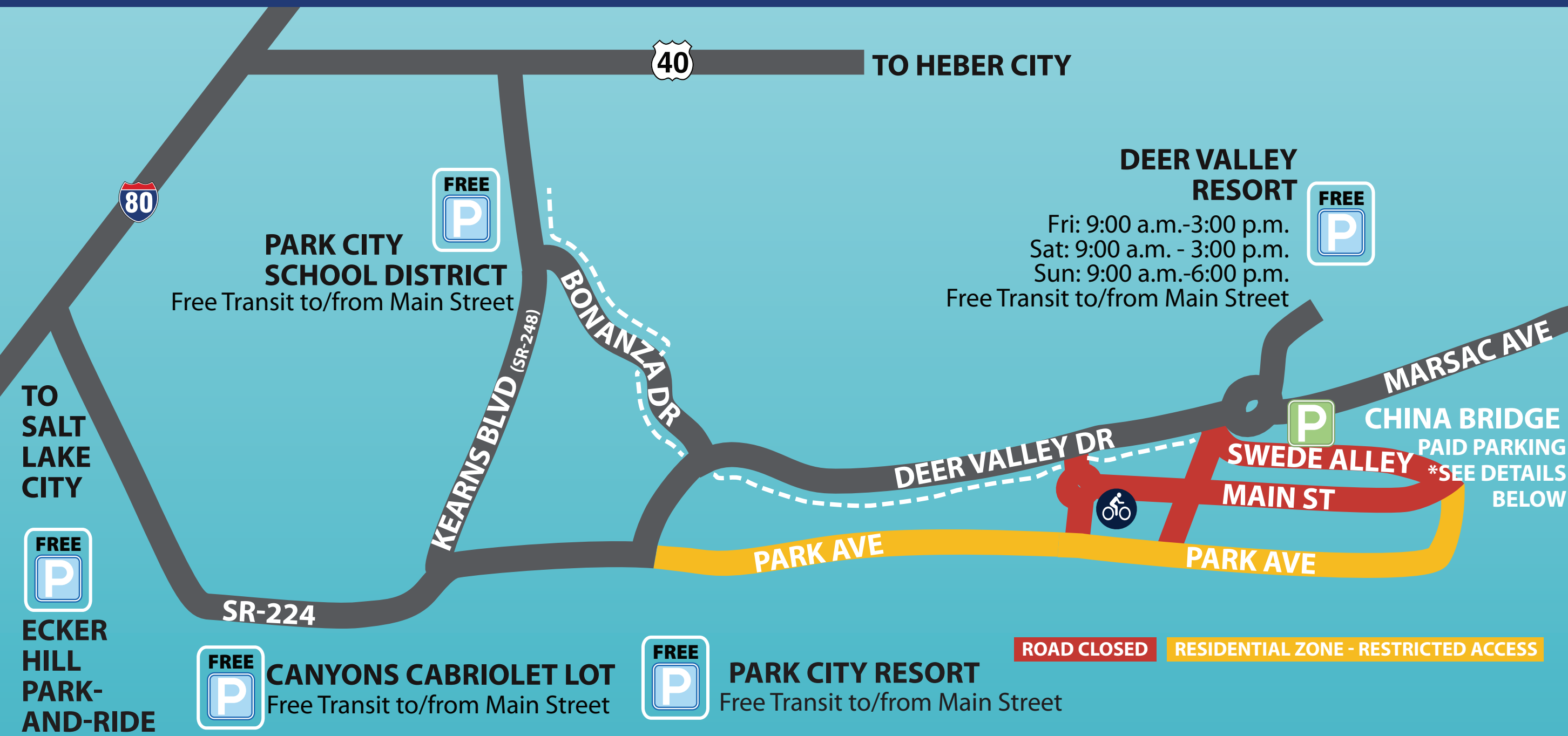

PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION IMPACTS



ROAD & PARKING CLOSURES

Main Street, Heber Avenue, Swede Alley, and Swede Alley surface lots will be closed to parking and traffic from 3:00 a.m. on Friday, August 2, through 11:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 4. Transportation access will be restricted in the Old Town area throughout the event.



BIKE, BUS, WALK, CARPOOL

Transportation impacts are expected throughout the event. Help reduce congestion and environmental impacts by taking Park City Transit, biking, walking, or carpooling to the event. Bike valet will be available on 7th Street. Please avoid cutting through residential neighborhoods - increased security in these areas is to be expected.



PAID PARKING

Paid Parking is available at China Bridge Parking Structure on Friday, August 2, \$3 per hour after 5:00 p.m./max rate \$18, first hour is free. Saturday and Sunday, August 3 and 4 from 9:00 to 5:00 p.m., \$5 hour/max rate \$18 (after 5:00 p.m. hourly rates are \$3 per hour/max \$18), first hour free. There are several private parking garages throughout Park City that offer paid parking. If driving to Main Street, allow extra time for travel. Parking is expected to fill quickly. To avoid congestion, plan ahead, take the bus, bike, walk or carpool.
