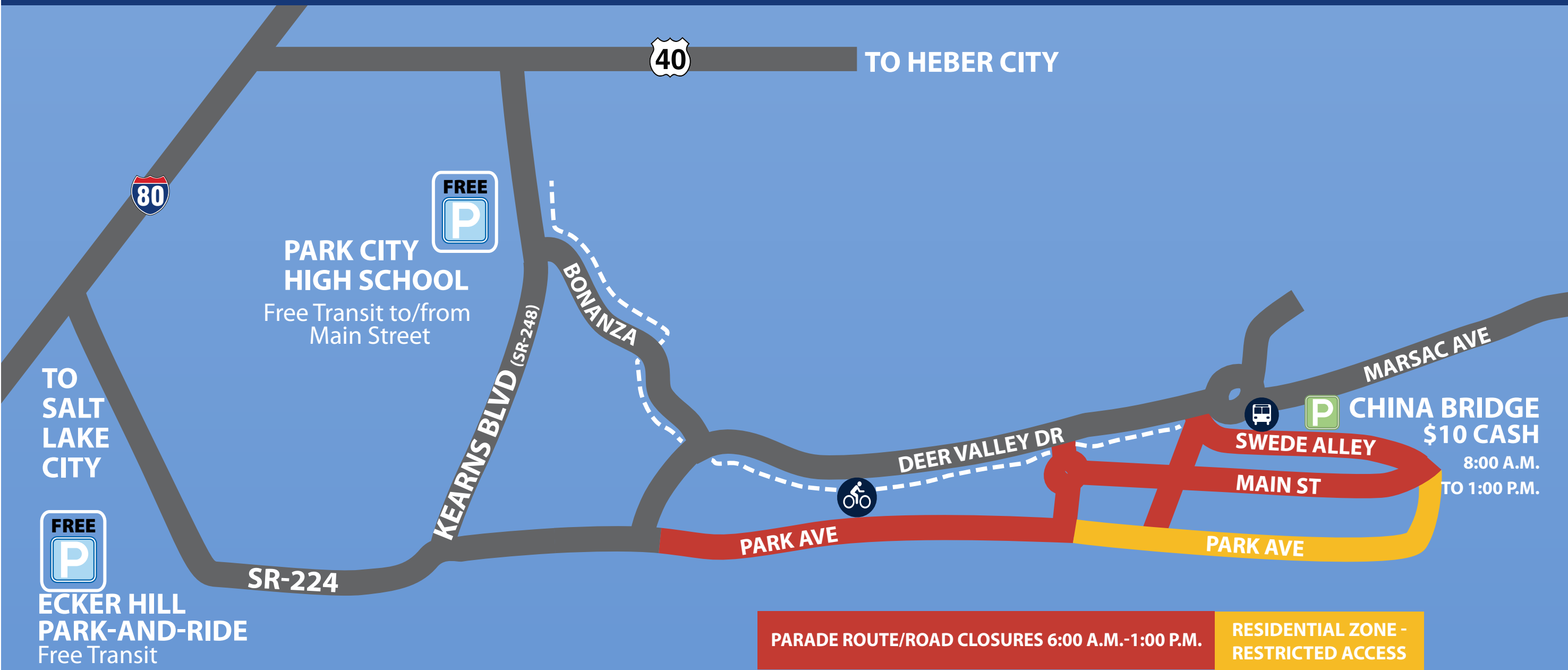

## Transportation Impacts



### PARADE ROUTE/ ROAD CLOSURES

Road Closures will be in effect on Main Street, Swede Alley, Swede Alley Surface Lots,, Heber Avenue, and Park Avenue (9th Street to 14th Street) on Monday, September 2, from 6:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. Transportation will be restricted in the Old Town area throughout the event. Be respectful - please do not cut through residential neighborhoods and expect increased security.



### BIKE, BUS, WALK, CARPOOL

Delays are expected during the event. Do your part to help reduce single occupant cars and minimize environmental impacts. We highly encourage residents and visitors to bus, bike, walk, or carpool to the event. Bike Valet is available at South City Park. Free Transit is available throughout Park City to the event.



### PARKING

Paid parking is available at China Bridge Parking Structure for \$10 cash preferred per vehicle from 8:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. There are several private parking garages throughout Park City that offer paid parking. Free parking is available at Park City School District with free transit to/from Main Street. If driving to Main Street, allow extra time for travel and to find parking spaces. Parking is expected to fill quickly. To avoid traffic and parking congestion, take the bus, bike, walk or carpool.
