


Howl-O-Ween on Main Street Thursday, October 31, 2019, 3:00 p.m.

Take the Frankenbus to the Spooky Old Town Transit Center! Support our community's critical priority of transportation. Take the bus, carpool, bike, or walk to help reduce and avoid transportation impacts. A Bus-Only lane will be implemented on Deer Valley Drive to expedite transit to Old Town. PARKING

Attendees are encouraged to park for FREE at the base of Park City Mountain, Deer Valley Resort, and at Park City High School. From 2:00-6:00 p.m., paid parking is available for \$10/car at China Bridge parking structure with entry from Marsac Avenue only. Vehicles may exit China Bridge on Swede Alley, but will only be permitted to turn right (north) on Swede Alley. There are several private parking garages throughout Park City that offer paid parking.



ROAD CLOSURES

All of Main Street will be closed to vehicles and parking from 2:00 p.m.-6:30 p.m. Main Street is expected to reopen at 6:30 p.m. Swede Alley will be one way only, headed north, from 2:00 - 6:30 p.m. during the event.
