EPA has discussed with the Utah Division of Solid & Hazardous Waste temporary disposal options for Park City's development related waste generated during the 2010 construction season. Park City should apply to the State Solid & Hazardous Waste Division for temporary disposal on Park City property, and include a plan of operation for management of the waste and financial assurance. Development related waste should be segregated before storage. This process can be expedited with the State and they are already informed of the exigent circumstances.
