NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

9 Prospect is a bungalow type house that has had significant changes made to both its form and materials. While the bungalow is not one of the main three house types built during the historic Park City mining era. A large dormer was added on the front façade along with several rear additions. In the most recent image, the gable roof is being resheathed in asphalt shingles. The house is clad with drop-novelty wood siding. The windows have been changed over the years, going from Chicago-style windows originally to aluminum sliders in the 1995 photo and then reverting back to newer Chicago-style windows by 2006. A one-over-one double hung sash window is in the dormer and two windows of unknown type in the gable front. The door is a frame and panel door that has an upper oval light. The porch is covered by a shed extension of the main roof which is supported by lathe turned wood posts with a similar balustrade stretching between the posts. A stacked stone retaining wall surrounds the front yard. The overall form and materials remain intact, however, the large dormer addition and side addition have diminished the historic value.

Narrative Statement of Significance:

Though there is a house present on the 1889 Sanborn Insurance map in the same location as this house, it appears to be very different from the house shown in the 1900 map, and was likely demolished before the present house was built. The first owners of the property when this house was built were likely Martha and Myron Horsford. Myron Horsford appears on the 1900 census of Park City, where it lists that he was a stationary engineer, but nothing else is known of him. They sold the house in 1900 to John Phillips.

John Phillips is listed on the 1900 census as living in Park City with his wife Emma and their daughter. John worked as a miner, but no other information could be found on their family. They sold the house to Katie Anderson in 1909.

Katie Anderson does not appear on the censuses for 1910 or 1920 in this house, so it is likely that the house was rented out during her ownership. The house does not appear on the 1920 census, indicating that it was vacant at that time. She sold it to Mary Barton in 1924.

Mary Barton appears on the 1920 census living on Empire Canyon. She lived there with her young daughter and a boarder. She worked as a dressmaker at that time, and was the provider for her family as her husband had died several years earlier. She sold the house in 1926 to Andy Wickman.

Andy Wickman lived at the house with his wife Amanda during the 1930 census. Both were born in Finland and came to the U.S. in the early around 1900. Andy worked as a miner. The property passed on to their daughter Hazel, who sold it in 1937 to Thomas Finnegan.

Thomas Finnegan appears on the 1940 census living on Ontario Ridge, at house number 8. It is possible that the census is referring to this house, because it is where the two streets fork, but this is unconfirmed. Thomas had a wife, Mary and a brother living with him. He worked as a millman for a mine. They sold the house in 1941 to Dolph Blackley. Dolph Blackley was a policeman who had lived in Park City for many years, but it is unknown if he ever lived in this house. The property has changed several hands since then, and is currently owned by Denise Kent and Alan Schueler.









9 Prospect St, Park City, Summit County, Utah Intensive Level Survey—Sanborn Map history
