Subject: Park Silly Sunday Market 2020 Cancellation

On April 20, 2020, Park City Municipal Corporation (PCMC/City) received Park Silly Sunday Market's (PSSM) letter of cancellation notice.

Due to Summit County Joint Public Health Order 2020-03, and Unforeseen Circumstances (section 18 of the City Service Agreement) regarding the impacts of COVID19, the City and PSSM mutually acknowledge the cancellation of the 2020 season is the best way to move forward given the uncertainty of future scope, rules/regulations and financial commitments for Mass Gatherings and Special Events.

The parties agree to release all commitments as outlined in City Service Agreement for the 2020 season. This includes but is not limited to Use Areas, Dates, Timelines, and Development of Supplemental Plans, Marketing, Financial and Insurance requirements. PSSM shall work in coordination with the City and partners such as the Historic Park City Alliance and Park City Chamber to inform the public and guests of the cancellation.

As of the date of this letter, to memorialize the request for cancellation of the 2020 Park Silly Sunday Market, both parties acknowledge the cancellation of the 2020 season as outlined above, and the intent to continue the event per the City Service Agreement in 2021 and 2022. The parties will work in good faith in the future to develop Supplemental Plans for future years along timelines as described in the City Services Agreement. Unless affirmatively modified by agreement of both parties, Supplemental Plans for future years will follow the plan for the previous Market season.
