PARKING CLOSURES AND ROAD CLOSURES

- **August 3 at 6:00 a.m. (Wednesday):** Bob Wells and Brew Pub Parking Lots will close.
- **August 5 at 3:00 a.m. through August 7 at midnight:** Main Street, Heber Avenue, Swede Alley, and Swede Alley remaining surface lots will be closed to parking and traffic. Transportation access will be restricted in the Old Town area throughout the event.

FREE PARKING AND FREE TRANSIT

- **Ecker Hill Park-and-Ride:** free parking at 2465 Kilby Road with free transit to/from Old Town.
- **Sandridge Lots:** free parking access via Marsac Avenue. Expected to fill quickly.
- **Park City School District (Kearns Blvd.):** free parking with free transit to/from Old Town.
- **Park City Mountain Resort:** free parking with free transit to/from Old Town.
- **Deer Valley Resort:** free parking with free transit to/from Old Town Saturday, August 6, 9:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m., and Sunday, August 7, 9:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.

**The last bus from Old Town Transit Center to Prospector/High School and Kimball Junction is 11:20 p.m. The earliest bus from the High School is 5:56 a.m. Check parkcitytransit.org or highvalleytransit.org for full schedules.*

PAID PARKING

China Bridge Parking Structure

- **Friday, August 5:** After 2:00 p.m. \$7/hour, maximum \$30 (free until 2:00 p.m.)
- **Saturday and Sunday, August 6-7:** \$7/hour from 10:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. (maximum rate of \$30). Free parking 4:00-6:00 p.m., standard rates apply after 6:00 p.m.

Private Parking Lots

- Available throughout Old Town, with varying regulations, pay structures, and costs.

PARKING PERMIT HOLDERS

- **Business, Employee and Carpool Permits:** may park in North Marsac Parking Lot (via Marsac Avenue) or Gateway Center upper lot (via Heber Avenue). If lots fill, permit holders may park in Sandridge and China Bridge as space allows.

TAXI STAGING/DROP-AND-LOAD

- Drop-and-load and taxi staging area will be available in the South Marsac Lot Friday, August 5 beginning at 8:00 a.m. until Sunday, August 7 at 10:00 p.m.

Only businesses and residents with private off-street parking on Park Avenue or Swede Alley will be provided an Access Pass. There is no public parking on Park Avenue or Swede Alley or other residential streets around old town. For questions about access passes, please text Jenny Diersen (contact information below)
