

VICTIM ADVOCACY PROGRAM

The program provides survivors with information and support through:

- Informing survivors of their rights
- Assisting with protective orders or stalking injunctions
- Providing referrals for counseling and reparations for medical expenses and loss of wage
- Assistance with shelter referrals and transportation as needed
- Information on and support throughout the criminal justice system
- Assistance in safety planning
- Information on community resources such as food assistance, emergency housing and other social services
