Frequently Asked Questions

1) What items can I sell?

Any hockey equipment related items. Any hockey training equipment. We will consider hockey related items such as hockey branded clothing, hockey books, etc. if we feel they will sell.

2) When can I drop off gear?

Scheduled times for drop off are 9/10 from 4-8pm, 9/12 from 4-8pm, and 9/13 from 4-8pm at the Park City Ice Arena.

3) I can't make the scheduled times for drop off. Can I still drop off gear?

If you just want to donate gear to put in the swap (and don't want the gear back or a payout if something sells), you may put your gear in a trash bag with your name and phone number and drop if off at the front desk of the Park City Ice Arena during normal business hours. We will put your items in the sale and all proceeds will go to youth hockey and the Park City Ice Miners. If you want a payout if something sells, you must drop off items during the drop off times listed above or make special arrangements with Yvette Connely.

4) Who prices the gear for the swap?

You are responsible for putting a value on the gear you want to sell. There will be a check-in sheet to fill out when you drop your stuff off. On that sheet you will list the item's description and the value you want to sell it for. The swap volunteers will then take your items and tag them with the value that you list. If you have a lot of items to sell and don't want to be at the rink that long, we recommend you do this at home before you come to the rink. You can request a copy of the sheet that needs to be filled out. If you are just donating the gear, a swap volunteer will estimate the used value, tag the items and put them in the swap.

5) Is there a consignment fee to sell items?

Yes, the Park City Ice Miners will take a 20% consignment fee for items that sell during the swap. Those monies will go back to youth hockey and the Park City Ice Miners.

6) What are the hours of the swap?

Sat., 9/14/24 from 8:00am to 3:00pm and Sun., 9/15/25 from 11:00am to 1:00pm. at the Park City Ice Arena.

7) If some of my gear sells, how will I get paid?

You can pick up your money on 9/15 from 1:30-3:00pm and 9/17 from 4:30-8:00pm at the Park City Ice Arena. If you cannot make those times, there is a spot on the check-in sheet to note payment options. We will notify you if you have funds to pick up and they are not picked up during the scheduled times.

8) When can I pick up my gear that does not sell in the swap?

If you want your items back that do not sell, you can pick those items up on 9/15 from 1:30-3:00pm and 9/17 from 4:30-8:00pm. If you cannot make those times, you can note this on the check-in sheet so arrangements can be made. If you want to donate the rest of your items that don't sell, there will be a place on the check-in sheet to note that. All items donated that did not sell during the swap will be donated to players in need.
