PARK CITY WATER DEPARTMENT IS REPAIRING A WATER LINE BREAK AFFECTING ALL HOUSEHOLDS ON DOC HOLLIDAY DRIVE AND SAMUEL COLT COURT. WE REGRET THE INCONVENIENCE AND ARE WORKING AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLY TO REPAIR THIS BREAK.

Is there water available?

The City is providing water for your drinking, cooking and other personal needs such as brushing your teeth. In addition to the water delivered to your house, there will be water available in the driveway at Mayor Dana Williams' house at 2384 Doc Holliday Drive.

Additionally we are providing a secondary water source in your neighborhood for flushing your toilet and other non-consumption/non-potable uses. It is a very large trailer and will be hard to miss. It is en route at the time of this flyer so the exact location will be posted on the water hotline at 435-615-5320.

How can I take a shower?

There are free showers available at the PC MARC (formerly the Racquet Club) at 1400 Little Kate Road. You will need to bring your own towel.

How do I get more information?

There is a City Water Hotline at 435-615-5320. We will update this message as additional water information becomes available. In addition we will post information to the City website at www.parkcity.org.

What do I do when the water comes back on?

Before using the water for the first time, please run all cold water taps for at least five minutes. If after 5 minutes the water is not running clear, please continue running your water until the water runs clear. This might take more than 5 minutes, so please do not be concerned.
